The Supply Chain Manager is responsible for developing business strategies to fulfill the metrics assigned by leadership. Oversee the entire supply chain process, ensuring efficient procurement, inventory management, and distribution of materials for our production needs. Maintain a system to track Department's performance through metrics. Develop plans, objectives, and strategies to meet or exceed performance through continuous improvement projects. Maintain a Quality Control (QC) process to ensure work accuracy. Work cross departmentally with sales, production, and service to provide insights to effectively support our customers. Review project budgets and recommend staffing and equipment as needed. Ensure FSGroup's custom food equipment manufacturing operations run smoothly and efficiently, contributing to the company's overall success and growth.

Responsibilities and Duties

- Collaborate with cross-functional teams to forecast material requirements based on production schedules and sales projections
- Develop and implement strategies to optimize inventory levels, reduce costs, and improve supply chain efficiency
- Manage relationships with suppliers, negotiating contracts and ensuring timely delivery of materials
- Oversee purchasing processes, including sourcing, negotiating, and procuring materials according to specifications
- Monitor inventory levels and conduct regular audits to maintain accuracy and compliance with company policies
- Ensure the validity of methods used by Department aligns with industry standards and FSGroup systems
- Propose project and program budgets; simultaneously track budgets, employees, and schedules
- Evaluate quality, price, reliability, technical support, and availability of goods and services
